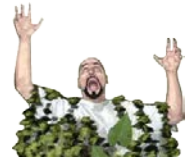

Find stigma (at end of the style) and describe it:  
3, lobed

Find anther, filament & pollen; describe the pollen grains:  
1 anther per stamen attached in middle, pollen is yellow and exits from slits

Find the ovary (at bottom of the pistil) and describe:  
axile placentation (ovules attached to central axis) and is superior (it is above the point of petal and/or sepal attachment)
